

My Water Cycle Phrase: Narration

Here is the “story” I am telling in my Water Cycle dance phrase. I am including appropriate Science and Dance vocabulary words to make a vivid word picture of my dance:

1. Solid Water	<i>What kind of solid water are you? What are you showing us with your body shape?</i>
2. Melting	<i>Are you melting in an unusual way or direction? What heat source is causing you to melt?</i>
3. Liquid Water	<i>What form of liquid water have you melted into? What are you thinking about here?</i>
4. Evaporation	<i>Is your heat source different, or did it just get hotter? Why? What does evaporation feel like?</i>
5. Water as a Gas or Vapor	<i>What form of vapor or gars have you become? How does that feel?</i>
6. Condensation	<i>Why is the air cooler? Where is your water condensing?</i>
7. Liquid Water	<i>Are you the same liquid form f water you were in step 3 above? Explain your choice.</i>
8. Freezing	<i>Why is it getting colder? What is happening to your water?</i>
9. Solid Water	<i>Have you changed your place in space? What are you thinking as you hold your final shape?</i>
